Holy Spirit to guide us through every moment of today. Amen**

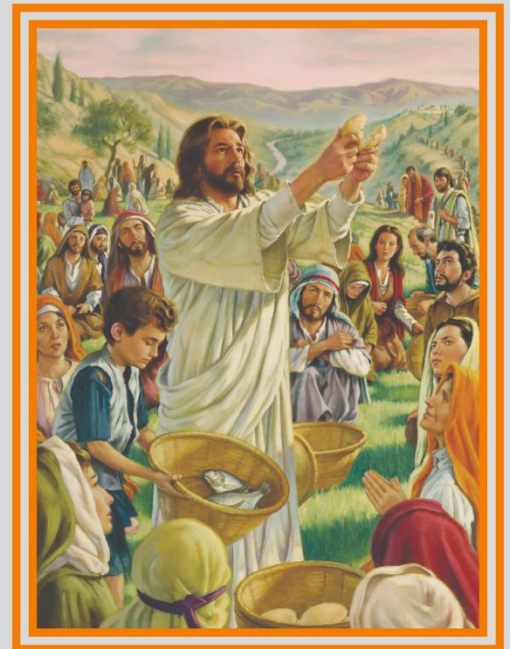
